Hello Qualicum School District Board Members,

I would like to review the numbers used to justify the recommendation to close a school, as per Section 1 of the current School Closure policy (3040),

1. Where the Board contemplates a school closure, it will take into consideration:
 - a. the extent of the potential impact on students, families and the community of the facility to be closed;
 - b. relevant factors such as enrolment projections, the physical condition of the school, available alternatives for students, catchment areas, effect on transportation services and alternative potential uses for the facility.

Could you please ensure the provision of information relevant to the recommendation to close a school as required by the current School Closure policy (3040), Section 4, that states:

4. "... the District will ... provide information relevant to the potential closure of any specific school", to
 - c. The community that is immediately and historically associated with the noted school(s).

Please provide the ...

- 1) funding formula (2010) with all inputs in .csv or .xls format,
- 2) catchment area boundary files (in shapefiles please),
- 3) catchment area level enrolment, since 1983

May I suggest that this information be made available to the public via the internet.
