*Provinces and Territories refer to Census Divisions using various terms such as Regional Districts in British Columbia, Divisions in Alberta, and Counties in Ontario.

Comparisons across scale, (from local to regional to provincial and national) add valuable insight.

Costs for National, Provincial/Territorial, and Economic Regions can be shared between the Census Divisions within. In other words, all CDs within an ER can split the cost for the ER. For example, the three CDs within the Kootenay ER can purchase Two Census Areas (the CD and the ER) to 2041, for \$1,334 or to 2051 for \$1,468.
